



**Regional and National Structures Task Force**  
**Terms of Reference**  
**February 2016**

This Task Force is responsible for promoting discussions and presenting recommendations on how Together 2030 should establish its **regional and national structures**.

Questions to be considered include, for instance:

- *What type of structures should Together 2030 set up at regional and national levels?*
- *What type of coordination should be established between the national, regional and global levels?*
- *What processes should be set to define national and regional structures of Together 2030?*
- *What actions should be prioritized at regional and national levels?*
- *What strategies should be set up to mobilize resources to support the work at national and regional levels?*

**Expected Deliverable:**

This Task Force is expected to present **concrete recommendations** for the setting up of regional and national structures of Together 2030. Those recommendations will then be considered by the Core Group for action.

**Duration:**

This will be a **short-term** Task Force. It will be disbanded after the recommendations document is finalized.

**Membership:** This Task Force is open to all members of Together 2030. Colleagues can join the Group during its lifespan although those joining after the start of consultations will need to conform to the deadlines established for the work.

**Working Methods**

All work will be conducted **remotely**. Virtual spaces for collaboration will be created to collect inputs from members of the Task Force. Webinars will be planned as the work develops. Colleagues needing accessible version of working documents should contact the Secretariat bilaterally.
